

## 7 DAYS / 6 NIGHTS BALI GARDEN ROUTE

Period : 2011 – March 2012  
Min Participant : 2 persons

### DAY 1 : BALI ARRIVAL - SANUR

Meeting service upon arrival at Ngurah Rai International Airport, then directly transfer to the hotel at Sanur Area. The rests of the day is free at own leisure.

### DAY 2 : SANUR / THE EXPERIENCE ADVENTURE ON 4WD (B,L)

Breakfast at the hotel. A day fun trip on 4WD Land Rover. Relax and enjoy with the native by visiting a Balinese family compound in Pinge, Marga Region where life is still simple. Enjoy coffee / tea and their friendly hospitality. Fantastic scenery along the way through the forest will be a memorable experience.

After that we experience a breeze of enjoyable boat ride through the Beratan Lake. A small organic farm tour will bring out the appetite. Celebrate the Indonesian way and have 'tumpeng' for lunch which will be serve in an organic farm. Nature scenes along the way will surely be the memory of your life.

### DAY 3 : SANUR – UBUD (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Pick up in the hotel in the morning for a Kintamani & Barong Dance tour before dropping at Ubud in the afternoon. The highlight of the tour is to see Mt. Batur at Kintamani. It is one of the most dramatic and accessible live volcano. Literally a volcano within a volcano, visitors can drive along the rim of a 8km wide caldera while looking across the still active Mt. Batur still spouting lava and slowly building new height. This tour includes:

- A morning presentation of the traditional Barong Dance. This dance drama portrays the eternal struggle between good and evil the religious and the profane ending when a group of men run amok attempting to stab themselves, only to be rescued from their frenzied trance by a local priests.
- The village of Mas; a community of wood workers. Ubud; to explore the village known for its many artisans. Mount Batur at Kintamani; a town perched on the edge of a volcano's rim offering panoramic views of a still active volcano and lake Batur below. Celuk; a community of silver craftsmen.
- Gunung Kawi Temple at Sebatu Village. It is not large so much, however, it is a quiet temple to which surroundings were enclosed by the forest. There is a fountain where the clear water that is called "Holy fountain" begins to spring in the temple.
- Beautiful rice terrace at Tegallalang will be the last stop.

### DAY 4 : UBUD – LOVINA (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, we take you to a full day tour exploring the North Coast of Bali. En route a visit to the Royal Temple of Taman Ayun at Mengwi - built in 17th century. This impressive temple is bordered by a wide moat, creating the sensation of standing in the middle of a lake. The temple itself has three ascending courtyards, each representing an increasing level of perfection in the Bali Hindu cosmos. The tour proceeds to the Ulundanu Water Temple at Bedugul - one of Bali's most beautiful temples; Git Git Waterfall – the tallest waterfall near Singaraja - the former capital of Bali; and Banjar - famous for its hot springs and Buddhist Monastery. Check in at the hotel around Lovina.

### DAY 5 : LOVINA - BELIMBING (B)

Early in the morning boarding a traditional boat called Jukung to see dolphins offshore of Lovina Beach in their natural habitat. Comeback to the hotel for breakfast and enjoy hotel and beach until check out in the afternoon. Proceed onto Belimbing Village. The scenic assets of Belimbing Village are highlighted by stretches of coffee and cocoa plantations, adding further natural beauty of this fresh-aired village. In addition, winding terraced padi fields present the spectator with magnificent scenery. Check in at the Cempaka Belimbing Villas for stay overnight.

### DAY 6 : BELIMBING - SANUR (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Today you will have a soft trekking to the rice field and watch the beautiful trees like Mangosteen, Clove, Nutmeg, Salak, Durian, Cacao and many other tropical trees you may have never seen before. See the authentic Bali as the Bali village and people like 30 years ago and enjoy the superb rice terraces and they are probably the most magnificent rice terraces on the island and the sloping of Mount Batukaru backs them up. In the afternoon, drive to Sanur. On the way, stops will

be made at Alas Kedaton Holy Monkey Forest, where hundreds of "tame" and very mischievous monkeys live in the forest surrounding the temple. The final stop of the day will be at the dramatic Tanah Lot sea temple. This is one of the splendid temples in Bali. Perching atop an enormous rock, it is completely surrounded by the waters of the Indian Ocean during high tide. Afternoon arriving at Sanur and check in at the hotel

### DAY 7 : DEPARTURE (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for departure.
