

## 7 DAYS/6NIGHTS NATURE ROUTE

Period : 2011 – March 2012  
Min Participant : 2 persons



### DAY 1 : BALI ARRIVAL – SANUR

Meeting service upon arrival at Ngurah Rai International Airport, then directly transfer to the hotel at Sanur Area. The rests of the day is free at own leisure.

### DAY 2 : SANUR – PEMUTERAN (B,L)

Breakfast at the hotel. On our way to Pemuteran, we will visit Tunjuk Village for almost a day activities as a local;  
Upon arrival at the village, you will be taken to visit a local school. Get the feeling interaction with the kids in the atmosphere of teaching and learning process upon visiting a local elementary school (subject to school holidays). Experience to be a teacher simply by introducing your home country and language thru a short sing and song.  
The next is visiting a unique Balinese houses setting where over fifteen family from one ancestor leaving harmoniously in one compound. Involve with them on their daily life to get a closely feeling, you will be welcomed.

Walking along with local farmers in a farmer hat and equipment toward the rice field could be something different. Further more, involve with them in traditional rice cultivating process up to planting rice is amazing experience in your life. While passing on the rice field, more variety vegetables could be seen and a chance of meeting other local farmers, then hold a short chat with them.

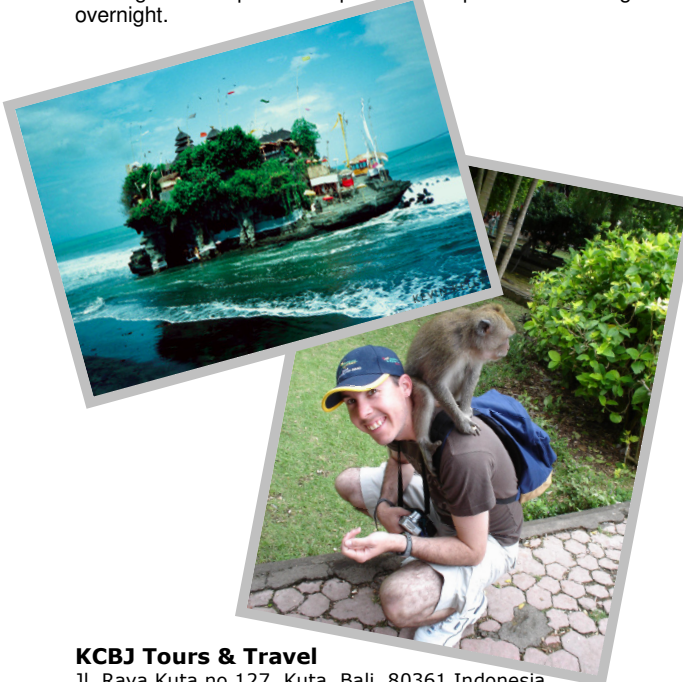
Enrich your knowledge with number of tropical fruit plantations and spices, while a local will demonstrate a climbing coconut. He will then serve you a young coconut as refreshment.

After being a farmer for over then four hours, a traditional set menu lunch will be served in a Balinese house compound with their family member.

The trip continued to Pemuteran, a stop to be made on the way at the Ulundanu Water Temple at Bedugul - one of Bali's most beautiful temples, and the drive through Munduk, enroute you will see beautiful scenery of plantation, mountain and rice terraces. In the afternoon arriving at Pemuteran for check in.

### DAY 3 : PEMUTERAN – BELIMBING (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Prepare your self for a day adventure to explore our national park on your feet OR boarding a boat to go to Menjangan Island for a snorkeling trip. In the afternoon, proceed onto Belimbing Village. The scenic assets of Belimbing Village are highlighted by stretches of coffee and cocoa plantations, adding further natural beauty of this fresh-aired village. In addition, winding terraced padi fields present the spectator with magnificent scenery. Check in at the Cempaka Belimbing Villas for stay overnight.



### DAY 4 : BELIMBING - UBUD (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Today you will have a soft trekking to the rice field and watch the beautiful trees like Mangosteen, Clove, Nutmeg, Salak, Durian, Cacao and many other tropical trees you may have never seen before. See the authentic Bali as the Bali village and people like 30 years ago and enjoy the superb rice terraces and they are probably the most magnificent rice terraces on the island and the sloping of Mount Batukaru backs them up. In the afternoon, drive to Ubud. On the way, a stop will be made at Tanah Lot Temple. This is one of the splendid temples in Bali. Perching atop an enormous rock, it is completely surrounded by the waters of the Indian Ocean during high tide sea, the next stop is Alas Kedaton Holy Monkey Forest, where hundreds of "tame" and very mischievous monkeys live in the forest surrounding the temple. Proceed to the Royal Temple of Taman Ayun at Mengwi - built in 17th century. This impressive temple is bordered by a wide moat, creating the sensation of standing in the middle of a lake. The temple itself has three ascending courtyards, each representing an increasing level of perfection in the Bali Hindu cosmos. Arriving in Ubud for check in at the hotel.

#### DAY 5 : UBUD – CANDIDASA (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. On your way to the eastern coasts of the island, we will drive you to some of the interesting places available on the region. Mt. Batur at Kintamani is the first of our visit. It is one of the most dramatic and accessible live volcano. Literally a volcano within a volcano, visitors can drive along the rim of a 8 km wide caldera while looking across the still active Mt. Batur still spouting lava and slowly building new height. After that drive to the Besakih Temple - the largest holy site in Bali and home to the island's Mother Temple, located on the slopes of Mount Agung (3,142 meters). The temple is comprised of 3 main complexes dedicated to the Hindu Trinity. It was built during the late 8th century AD. Proceed onto Bukit Jambul - gorgeous rice-terraced fields. Continued onto Klungkung to see Court House of Justice - Constructed in the late 18th century, the walls and ceilings are covered with paintings depicting episodes and scenes of the horrors awaiting those who do evil while on earth. A visit to the adjoining Bale Kambang (Floating Pavilion) and nearby museum complex. The final stop is the Goa Lawah (bat cave) – believed to be connected directly to sacred Mt. Agung. The roof of this cave is blanketed by thousands of bats; an awesome sight, especially if the resident pythons have crawled out on a ledge to "eye" the tourists and worshippers.



#### DAY 6 : CANDIDASA – SANUR (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Free in the morning. Check out and drive back to Sanur. We will visit the native Balinese village called Tenganan. An original Balinese 'aga' village and home to a distinctive ancient culture where strict mores and cultural taboos are still rigidly enforced. Distinctly different from other villages in Bali with its broad avenues and its rare geringsing weaving methods. Before reaching Sanur, some stops are also possible at Celuk Village to see skilled Balinese silver smiths and Tohpati Village the home of Balinese Batik and boutique experts.

#### DAY 7 : SANUR – DEPARTURE

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for departure.
